Creating a favicon: for the web browser

A favicon /'fæv.ɪ.kɒn/ (short for favorite icon), also known as a shortcut icon, website icon, tab icon, URL icon, or bookmark icon, is a file containing one or more small icons, associated with a particular website or web page.

1. Save your animal image for the web

2. Go to a favicon generating website

4. You can generate your own icon simply by creating a very small icon and placing it in your html <head>

The format for the image you have chosen must be 16x16 pixels or 32x32 pixels, using either 8-bit or 24-bit colors. The format of the image must be one of PNG (a W3C standard), GIF, a great thing to practice.

### *Assignment 3*

Create a selfie using one typeface only.

This assignment is about exploring different typefaces. A typeface is a specific design of type, (helvetica, bodini, comic sans )

while a font is a type in a particular size and weight : 12pt, italic, 13.5 leading

HOW TO:

1. Take a selfie - be playful - have fun, pull a face try to add some humor - think emoticon
2. Create a folder <selfie\_angela> - this will be used to save all your images in one place - they call this organization
3. Import onto the desktop and place in folder
4. Create a new document - US paper or 8.5" x 11"
5. Mark you save area on the page - the image should be set at 7.5" x 9.5" (you are to leave more room at the bottom of the page - 1" x .5" x .5" x .5")
  1. rulers are under 'view' then to mark the page boundaries - pull from edge
6. Place your selfie on the bottom layer - lock
7. Choose a typeface from you computer - ( no downloading but remember MAC + PC typefaces do not always match)
8. Look at all the shapes of the letters and numbers, upper and lower case ...
9. Do not loose the integrity of your typeface - that means no stretching, squishing, cutting - this assignment is all about getting to know type - the look, the feel and the possibilities of it as a shape not a letter.

10. Look at the blog and sketch up and think about how you are tackle the visual - shading, value, line, photorealism? How will you crop the image?
11. This is a black and white project - NO COLOR
12. Make sure you utilize your frame - you must touch at least 2 sides of the page
13. Save for the web, post on your blog with a paragraph statement.
14. The statement needs to say which typeface you used, why you used it and a bit of history about the typeface.
15. Print on heavy stock and bring into DUE: 3.11.2017
